2009 ADULT SUMMER SOFTBALL REGISTRATION



The Cincinnati Recreation Commission begins registration for the 2009 Summer Softball season on **Monday, May 4, 2009**. **League play begins Sunday, June 14, 2009 or as soon as spring leagues are completed. All games for the summer session will be played at Schmidt fields**

Priority Registration – for teams who played in **summer 2008** – will take place from **Monday, May 4, 2009 to Wednesday, May 13, 2009**.

Open Registration for all new teams and those who may have missed priority will start on **Thursday, May 14, 2009**, and continue until leagues fill.

The fee for an 8 game season is **\$285 for an unlighted league and \$350 for a lighted league. Umpire fees, game balls and bases are included in the entry fee.**

Applications and payment will be accepted at the CRC Athletic Office Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. Payment may be made with cash (in person only), check, money order or Visa/MasterCard. Credit card payments for applications that are faxed in (352-1605) **require that YOU** phone the Athletics Division with the credit card number and expiration date to complete the registration process.

Teams withdrawing prior to completion of league schedules will be assessed a \$25 service charge for clerical & material fees. Teams withdrawing after completion of schedules will be assessed \$50 plus a prorated game fee. Teams withdrawing after the second game will receive no refund.

Again, registration **is not** completed until you have **phoned** the Athletic Office and made payment.

Rosters are due in the Athletics office before the first played game. Rosters and rulebook are available on the web site. The **manager's signature** is required for the roster to be acceptable.
