Proposed Number of On-Street Parking Spaces Required. Existing Site Plan – A CAGIS Map-Based Diagram Layout, including: Both sides of the street. The intersection and both sides of all intersecting streets as applicable. The existing on-street parking layout. Existing traffic control and curb control sign locations and sign type / sign text. Existing parking meters, mobile parking payment signs, pay for parking kiosks. Proposed Site Plan – A CAGIS Map-Based Diagram Layout, including: Both sides of the street. The intersection and both sides of all intersecting streets as applicable. The proposed on-street parking layout. The proposed location of the EVSE charging station unit(s). Proposed traffic control and curb control sign locations and sign type / sign text. Proposed parking meters, mobile parking payment signs, pay for parking kiosks. Dimensions – Proposed Site Plan, including: Required accessibility & off-set dimensions as included in both the Contract & Design Guidelines. Proposed Traffic Control & Curb Control Sign Removals, Modifications, and/or Additions. Proposed Parking Meters and/or Parking Kiosks and/or Parking Signs Removals, Modifications, and/or Additions.
