## Station X Helps Covington Police Capture Suspects

Station X reached across the Ohio River early Monday to seize two suspects five minutes, after the holdup of a Kroger Grocery & Baking Co. store at 15th-st and Maryland-av, Covington.

Shortly after William Wilson, manager, 3150 Clifford-av, Covington, opened the store, two men entered and robbed him of \$57.25.

As the pair fied, Wilson ran to a nearby oil station and called Covington police, who relayed the report to Station X.

It was broadcast and John R. Triplett and Fred Gulick, Covington patrolmen, rushed to the scene of the holdup. Three blocks away, at 18th-st and Maryland-av, they captured the two men who regis-

## tered as James Farley, 42, and Frank Delano, 30, both homeless. Wilson identified both men. A pistol was found in Delano's possession, according to police.
