

City Radio Operators Ask \$90 Scale

Operators and technicians of Cincinnati's police radio station WKDU (known to many as Station X) said Saturday they are trying to arrange a conference with City Manager Kellogg to discuss higher pay rates.

Members of the group recently joined Local 1224, Radio Broadcast Technicians (AFL). A spokesman for the group said that at a conference three weeks ago, City Manager Kellogg said an "adjustment" of the present wage scale of \$66.35 a week is to be made in the near future. At that time, the new scale had not been set.

The WKDU employes are asking that their pay be boosted to \$90 a week, pointing out that persons holding similar jobs on commercial stations get \$101.50 a week.
