

Kellogg Lauds City Towing Law

City Manager Kellogg told Council Tuesday that the towing procedure by which traffic accidents now are cleaned up in Cincinnati "has been successful in general."

Mr. Kellogg said that in the first year of operation under an ordinance licensing towmen, police radio Station X has handled 847 requests for wreckers. Police summoned towmen in such cases on a rotation basis.

The city manager suggested no major changes in the ordinance, and noted that 28 towing firms now are licensed by the city. Only improvement Mr. Kellogg suggested concerned minor procedures on how towmen should be summoned.
