Harrell Asks City Council For \$5000 To "Holdup-Proof" Police Station X

City Manager C. A. Harrell yesterday asked City Council for authority to spend \$5000 for "holdup-proofing" police radio station X in Eden Park.

The security measures are necessary, he said, because Station X is manned by unarmed police personnel and "is exceedingly vulnerable to any intruder who might decide to dictate dispatching of police equipment to his own advantage."

The plan provides for installation of an alarm system, bulletproof glass and wire mesh enclosures for personnel, and two wire mesh doors with automatic time switches operated from within Station X.
