## New Police Radio Set Up In Kentucky

The new Campbell county (Ky.) police two-way radio system went on the air for the first time Thursday.

Installed at a cost of about \$8000, center of the system is at Alexandria, where a dispatcher  $w^{311}$  be available around the  $\clubsuit$  ock.
