QUEEN CITY MOTORISTS were pulled over and handed 232,711 traffic tags last year, an average of 637 a day and nearly 20,000 more than the year before. Written guilty please were filed (and court appearances avoided) by 69 per cent of them.

• Station X was "on the air" 1,325,901 times in 1967. This included 730 calls handled for city departments other than police and 404 messages relayed for other cities (at 50 cents a message).

 Police Department's 242 cruisers and motorcycles logged 6,250,000 miles last year.

• Missing Persons Bureau received 2071 missingperson reports in 1967. It found 2407 (presumably including many reported missing in 1966).
