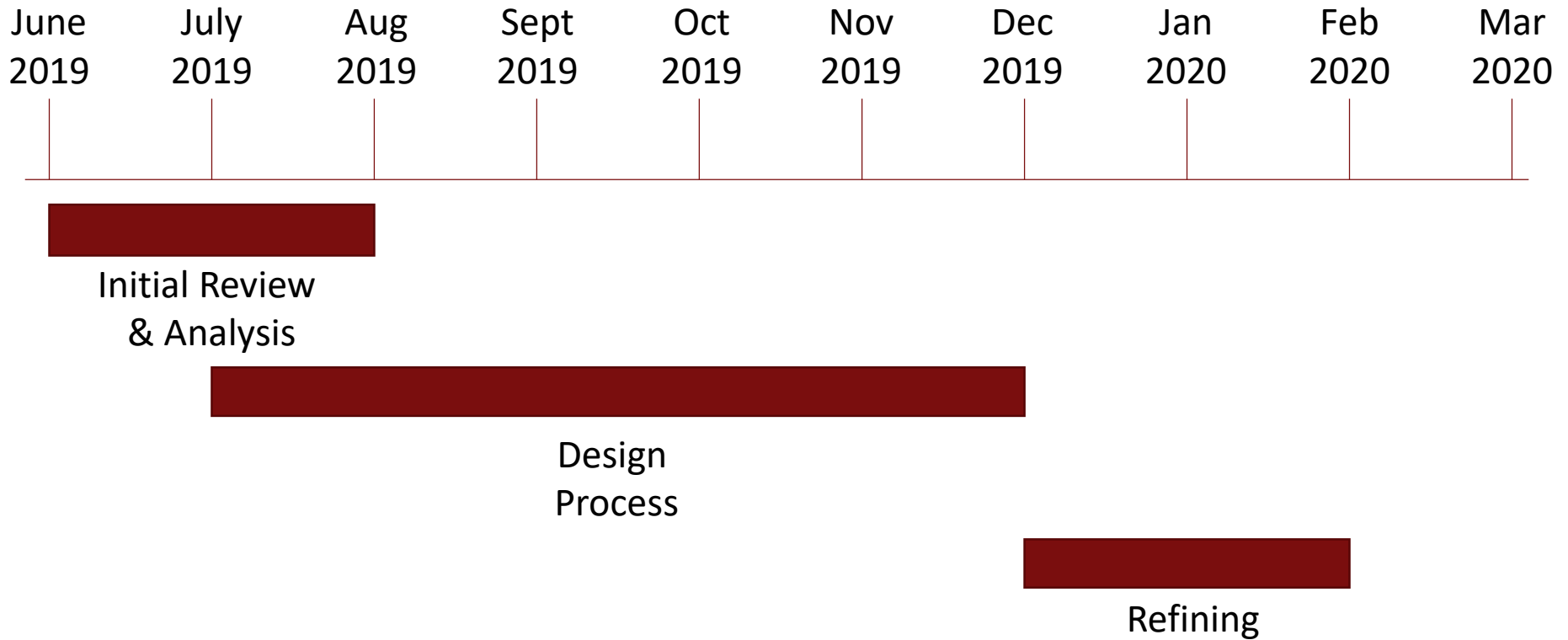
Systematic literature review of current metrics

Preliminary report of all metrics (3 pages or less per metric)

Systematic ratings of all metrics by key stakeholders & OPDA

Presentation & discussion of preliminary report & ratings

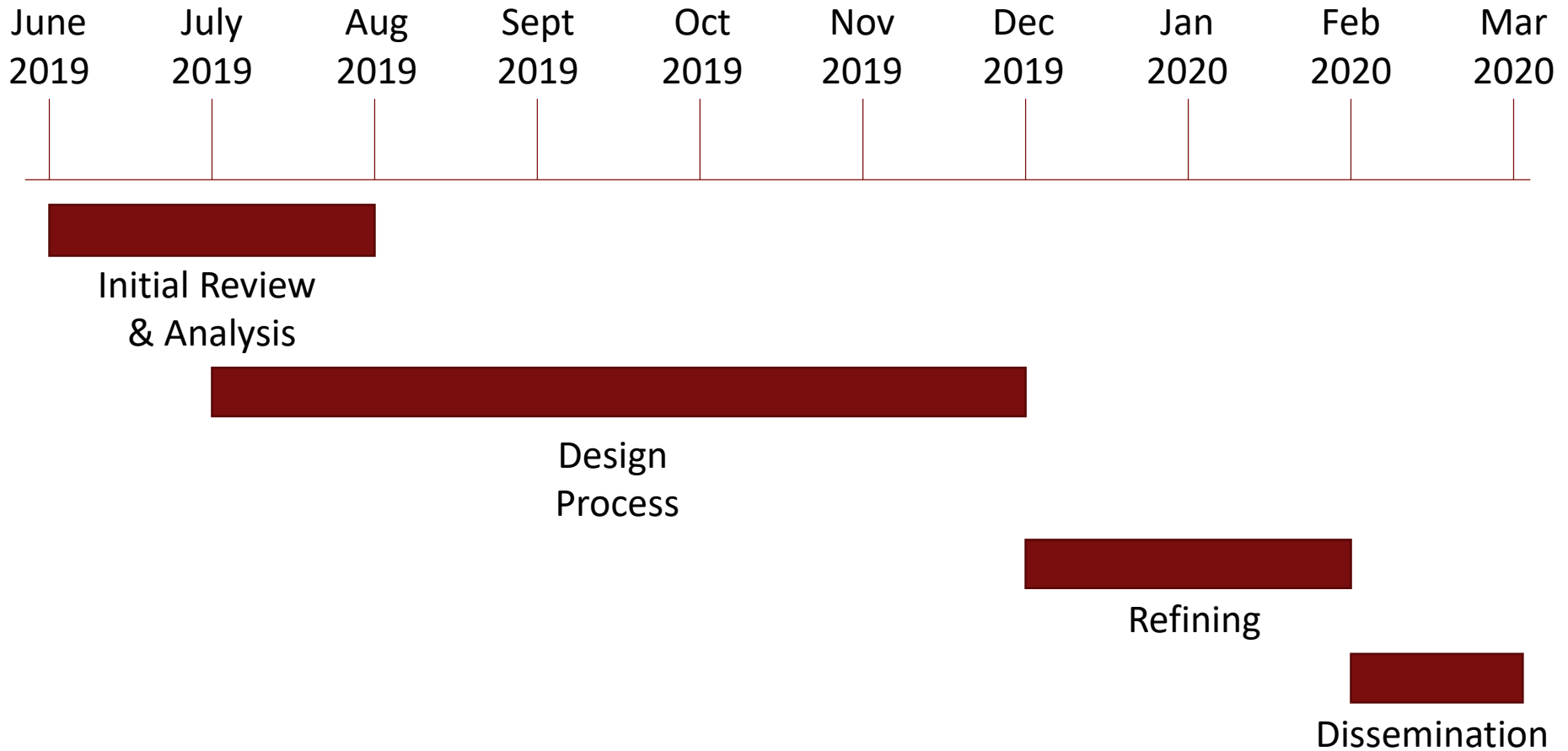


Refining the Analytical Framework

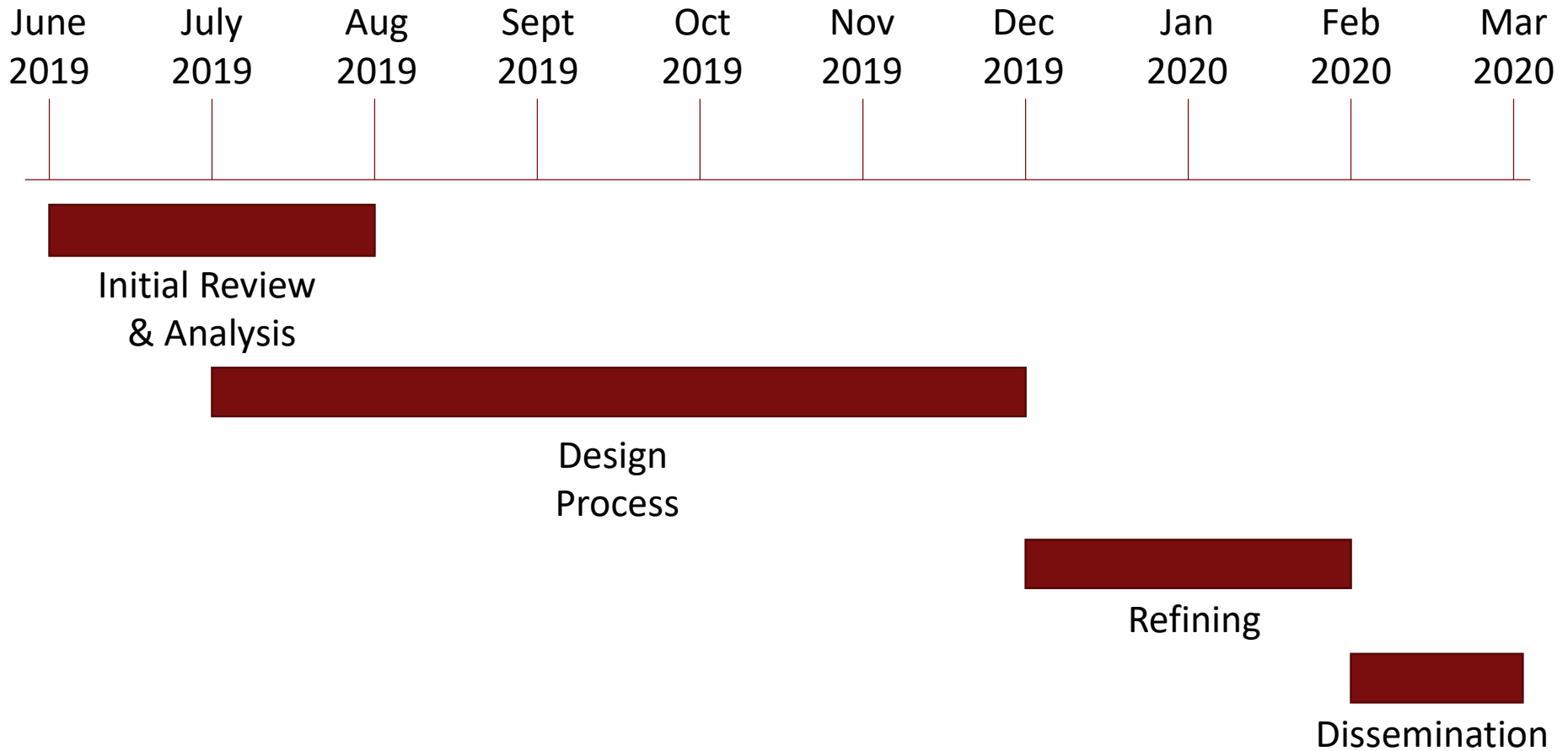


Disseminate Framework
