# Suggestions for possible changes to bylaws:

Add language to EAB By-laws Article II, section F:

# Option 1:

Every member of the Board is expected to attend a minimum of two-thirds of the meetings of the Board in any calendar year. Any member who fails to meet this minimum requirement will be presumed to have resigned.

#### Option 2.

Any Board member unable to attend a meeting shall notify the Secretary by telephone or e-mail at least one business day before the meeting. Three or more consecutive unexcused absences during any calendar year will result in the Secretary issuing a letter to the Board member seeking their resignation from the Board.
