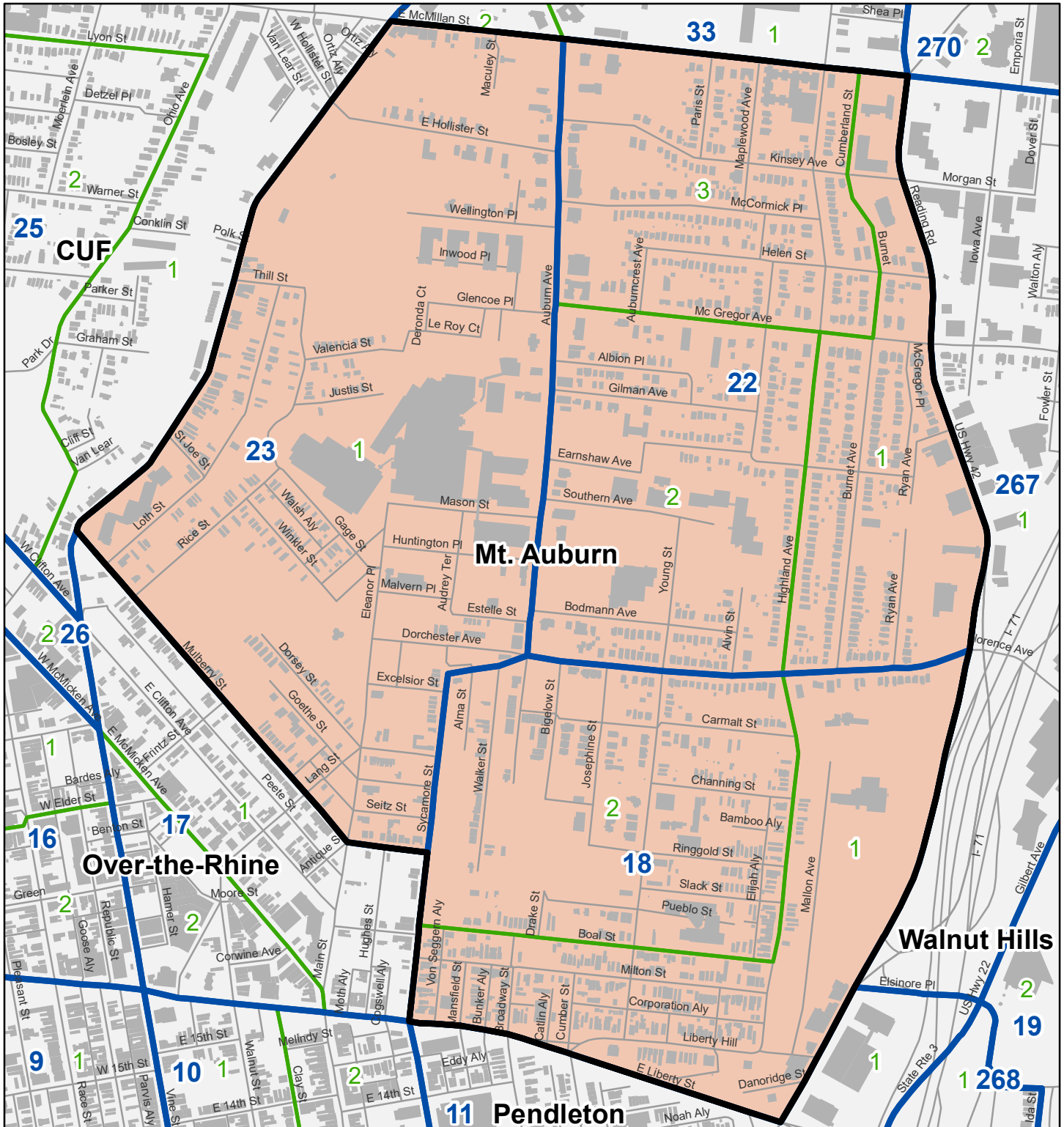

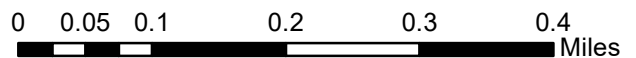
2020 Statistical Neighborhood Approximation*
