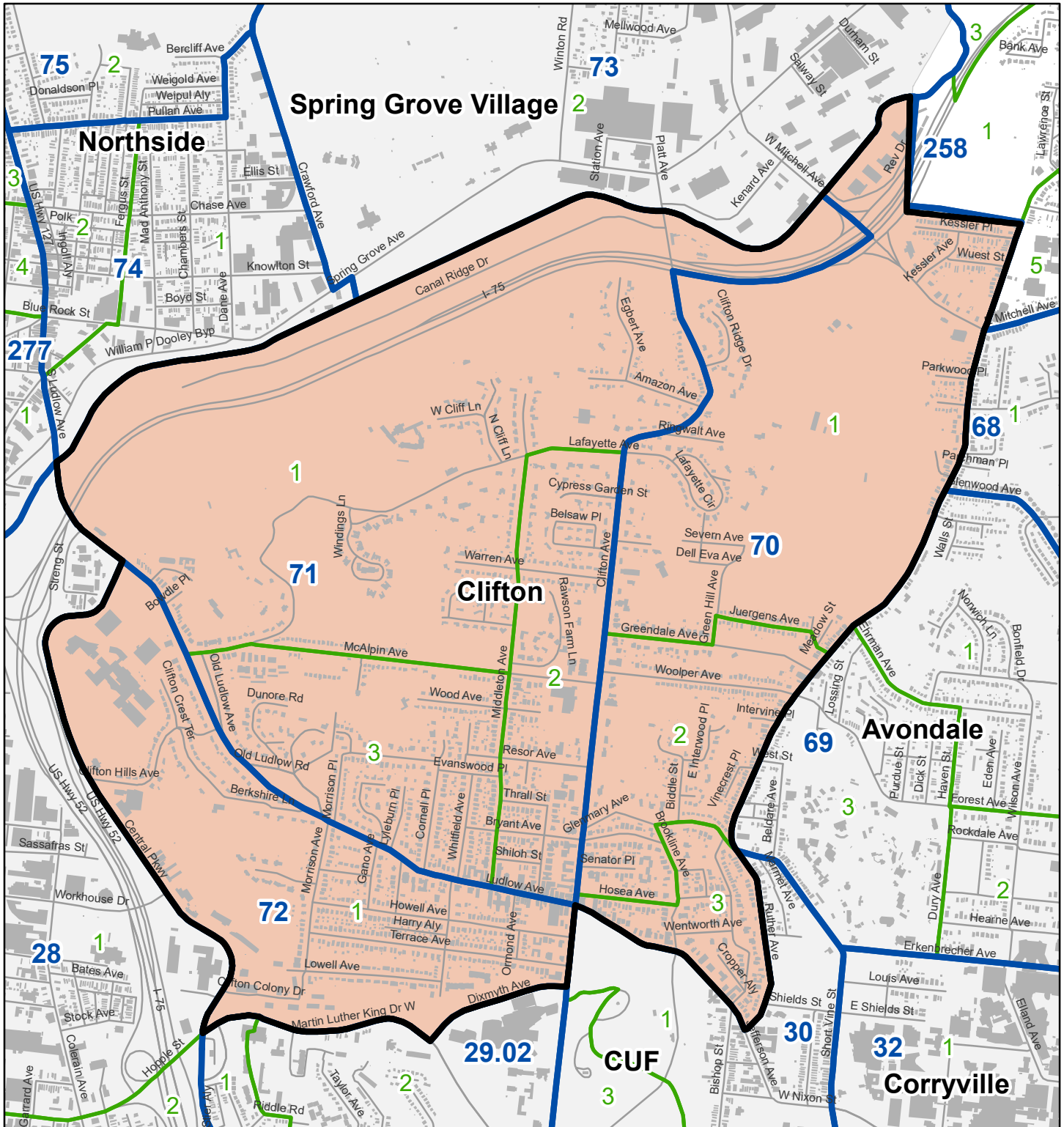

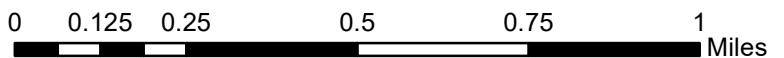
2020 Statistical Neighborhood Approximation\*
