

NOTICE OF A VIRTUAL PUBLIC STAFF CONFERENCE ON PROPOSED ZONE CHANGES LOCATED ALONG AND ADJACENT TO THE LICK RUN GREENWAY CORRIDOR IN SOUTH FAIRMOUNT

The Department of City Planning and Engagement conducted a zoning study in response to a request from the South Fairmount Community Council to study the area including and around the Lick Run Greenway. In February 2020, the American Institute of Architects (AIA) Cincinnati organized a "Public Participation Urban Design Workshop" in partnership with the South Fairmount Community Council to explore the area around the Lick Run Greenway since the greenway construction was nearing completion. During the workshop, community members shared their vision for the area surrounding the Lick Run Greenway.

The Department of City Planning and Engagement conducted a zoning analysis with the above context. During the process, City Planning and Engagement engaged the Metropolitan Sewer District, Department of Community and Economic Development, and the Department of Transportation and Engineering. These proposed zone changes are a result of over 2.5 years of analysis and community input.
