# **4** Medicare Advantage Plan Post-Implementation

P. Tilsley reported that the Plan is within 1.5 percent of headcount with a 2 percent increase in the Medicare Advantage population. Those that did not or do not currently have Part B Medicare are moved to the commercial side rather than lose coverage.

T. Gamel informed the Trustees that K. Rahtz will step down from chairing the Election Committee because of running for re-election and S. Dietrich will now serve as chair of the Election Committee. The remaining Election Committee members are D. Stiens and M. Berliant.
